

**Ancient Greek Architecture:
Food Drive and Sculpture Contest for Second Harvest of Southern Wisconsin**

Date: Thursday, April 26th 2007

Time: 4pm to 6:15pm

Location: Library Mall

Event: Teams will be building sculptures out of food items to be donated to Second Harvest of Southern Wisconsin (please see below for appropriate donations). Before building begins, each team must count their total number of food items with a Greek Week volunteer. This number must be reported to the person running the event by 4:15pm to receive points for food donated. Ten non-food items are allowed in the sculpture during the judging time but **must be removed from the donation area before the Second Harvest truck arrives**. Each team will be given a section of Library Mall to build their sculpture. These sculptures will be judged upon creativity and number of food items in the sculpture. **Teams must stay and load their donations onto the Second Harvest truck to receive any points.**

Schedule:

Counting Time: 4pm to 4:15pm

Building Time: 4:15pm to 5:30pm

Judging: 5:30pm to 6pm

Loading Truck: 6pm to 6:15pm

Points:

25 points for 1st place finishing team

20 points for 2nd place finishing team

15 point for 3rd place finishing team

1 point for every 5 items of food donated (25 points max)
