

## **Greeks Take Over Bascom Hill**

**Date:** Thursday, April 19<sup>th</sup> (Thursday BEFORE Greek Week)

**Time:** Set up: 10a-12p, Take Down: 7-8p

**Location:** Lower Third of Bascom Hill

**Event:** This day will be a HUGE PR event to let campus know about Greek Week! Pairings will put up 4 signs and 1 banner advertising Greek Week on Bascom Hill.

The banner will be the size of a full-size bed sheet, of any color you choose (you are responsible for purchasing the bed sheet – cheap low thread count options are available for under \$10). Be creative! These will be reused on the Saturday of the Crazylegs race and displayed on Langdon St. Banners **MUST** have the following: “Greek Week 2007” and the date, April 22-28<sup>th</sup>. The design should also display our theme, Ancient Greeks, either through an appropriate picture or slogan. Banners will be approved by a Greek Week committee member during set-up on the 19<sup>th</sup> and if they are at all inappropriate, you will not receive points for the event. Teams will have a pre-determined spot on the hill, so check with the Greek Week representative at the bottom of the hill when you arrive. Also, in the case of VERY inclement weather (heavy rain/snow) the event will not take place. If there is light rain, the event will be on.

Teams will need to provide the sheet as well as paint for the banners. Metal stakes to keep the banners in place will be provided.

Each team will also construct 4 signs (white in color, appx. 18” long, 12” high, size is somewhat flexible). Each team will receive 1 fact about the Greek community’s accomplishments over the years and will construct a series of signs that will show positive Greek contributions. These signs will be displayed in consecutive order for people to read on Bascom Hill.

An example of the signs is as follows:

Sign number 1: Did you know...

Sign number 2: Greeks have

Sign number 3: Contributed x numbers of service hrs for this semester!

Sign number 4: GREEK WEEK 2007, April 22-28<sup>th</sup>

Again, be creative with these—TONS of people will see them throughout the day!

Your teams will need to provide 4 signs along with attached wooden stakes to hold the signs upright in the ground, as well as paint/markers to decorate them.

### **Points:**

25 total for participation. **If your signs/banner are not up by 12:00 noon you will lose 5 points, and if they are not taken down by 8:00 p.m. you will lose 10 points.**
